Dr. Jack Killgore Biography

Dr. Jack Killgore is a Research Fishery Biologist in the Environmental Laboratory, Engineer Research and Development Center (ERDC), Vicksburg, Mississippi. He received a BA from University of Arkansas, Fayetteville; MS from Sam Houston State University, Huntsville, Texas; and a Ph.D. from the University of Mississippi, Oxford. Dr. Killgore is Leader of the Fish Ecology Team comprised of six federal scientists and five to eight contract staff depending on seasonal student employment. Over the past 25 years, a total of 173 peer-review and 111 government publications (e.g., technical reports, information bulletins, technical notes) have been completed by the Team through 2015. Research focuses on environmental biology of fishes, threatened (sturgeon) and invasive (Asian carp) fish species, ecosystem restoration in large river systems, and environmental impact assessment of Corps of Engineers flood risk reduction and navigation projects.
