

#### Agreement with local fire/rescue organization

One of the local fire and rescue groups that we deal with here at Blue Marsh Lake has approached us about getting reimbursed for expenses they have when responding to an incident on Corps property. They are a small rural all volunteer fire department with a small budget. I have done my research and found the section in ER-1130-2-550 section v. which references Title 42 USC Section 1856a which allows the Corps to enter into agreements for reimbursement of cost associated in providing fire protection(and rescue services). I checked with my operations chief and office of counsel and they are willing to look into this issue. My question is.. does anyone have an agreement to reimburse costs? How do you make payment? Does anyone have an example that we could use as a baseline to develop our agreement? I did check and they is no one in North Atlantic Division that is doing this, so it is new ground for us. I am moving very slowly on this issue, because if I do it for one dept, the other 3 departments that surround the lake will be waiting in line with their hands out also. Thanks in advance,

- Job postings If it is a promotion opportunity, post a job announcement in the Forum so many will see. If it is a new position (i.e. GS-4), the target audience will not be on the mailing list.

# BEFORE YOU COMMENT OR START NEW THREAD:

- Is your question strictly a local issue that could be answered at your lake/district? –
   Ask locally before asking nationwide.
- *Is it strictly work-related?* No politics, fundraising, or other prohibited topics.
- Are your remarks professional? No critical remarks about the agency or personnel; no foul language.
