


The mission of Backcountry

Fair Chase



BHA has chapters in 48 states, Washington D.C., 2 Canadian provinces, and 1 Canadian territory


MEMBERS






Importance of Volunteer Projects!

- Fence removal, modification, inventory, and construction
- Guzzler or water catchment installation and maintance
- Clean ups
- Plantings
- Invasive removal
- Trail clearning, maintanence, decommissioning
- Stream restoration
- Chainsaw trainings
- Mastication



Responsible OHV Use and Management

BHA offers up to \$500 in rewards for reports or information leading to a conviction of illegal motorized users. Report illegal OHV use to your local game warden and/or land manager and help ensure that we continue to have quality habitat, hunts, and access for all.

FOOT, HORSE AND NON-MOTORIZED BICYCLE TRAVEL WELCOME






