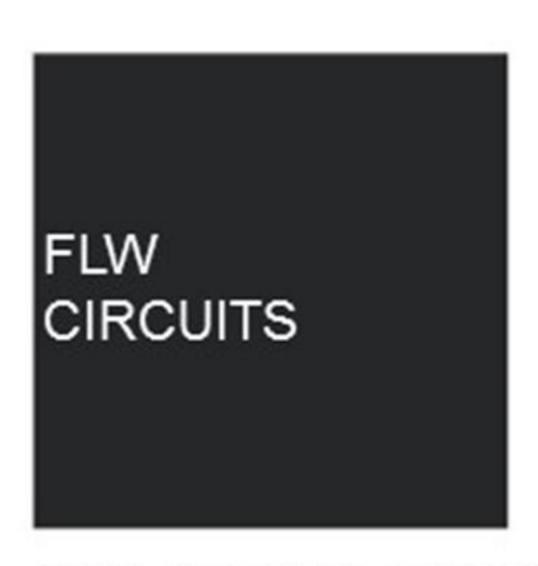

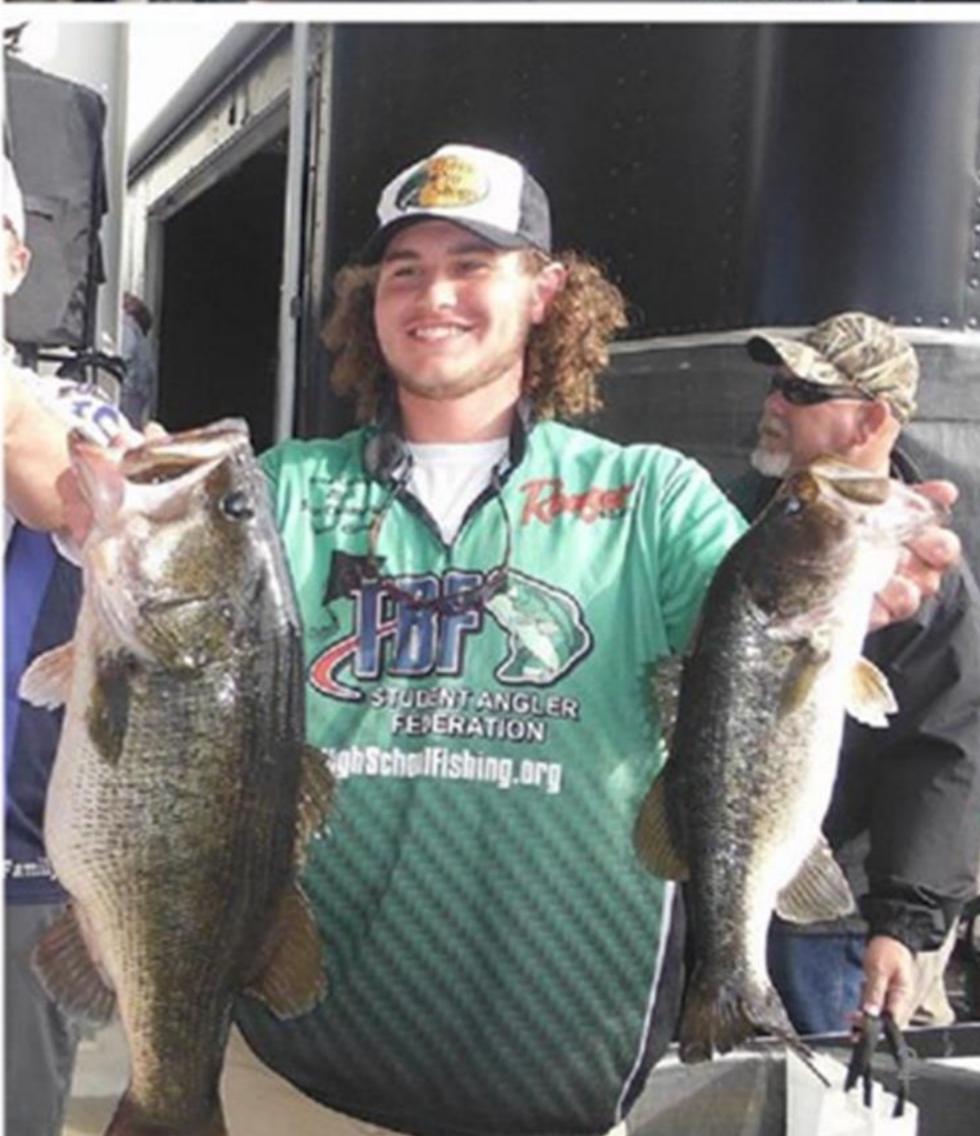
## HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL TOURNAMENTS 74 EVENTS

Opens, Challenges and State Championships advance the top 10 percent of teams to the National Championship.

The National Championship team receives a \$10,000 scholarship (\$5,000 per student).

More than 15,000 students participated in 2016.







## HIGH SCHOOL FISHING IS ONE OF THE FASTEST GROWING HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS IN THE NATION.

- A high school bass fishing championship is held in every state in the continental United States plus the province of Ontario, recruiting a record number of youth to the sport
- This is the only <u>national</u> High School Fishing program
- In 2011: 930 Students representing 385 teams participated
- In 2012: 2,790 Students representing 657 teams participated (200% growth) in 39 states
- In 2013: 5,724 Students representing 1,270 teams (93% growth)
- In 2014: 10,000 students (80% growth) representing 1,600 teams in 47 states and Ontario
- In 2015: 13,000 students competed
- In 2016: 15,520 students participated nationwide
- Illinois and Kentucky sanction fishing as an official high school sport
- Support of high school fishing programs offers the entire fishing industry a platform to grow participation, not only among students, but also their parents and grandparents
- HighSchoolFishing.org and CollegeFishing.com together receive nearly 1 million page views per month

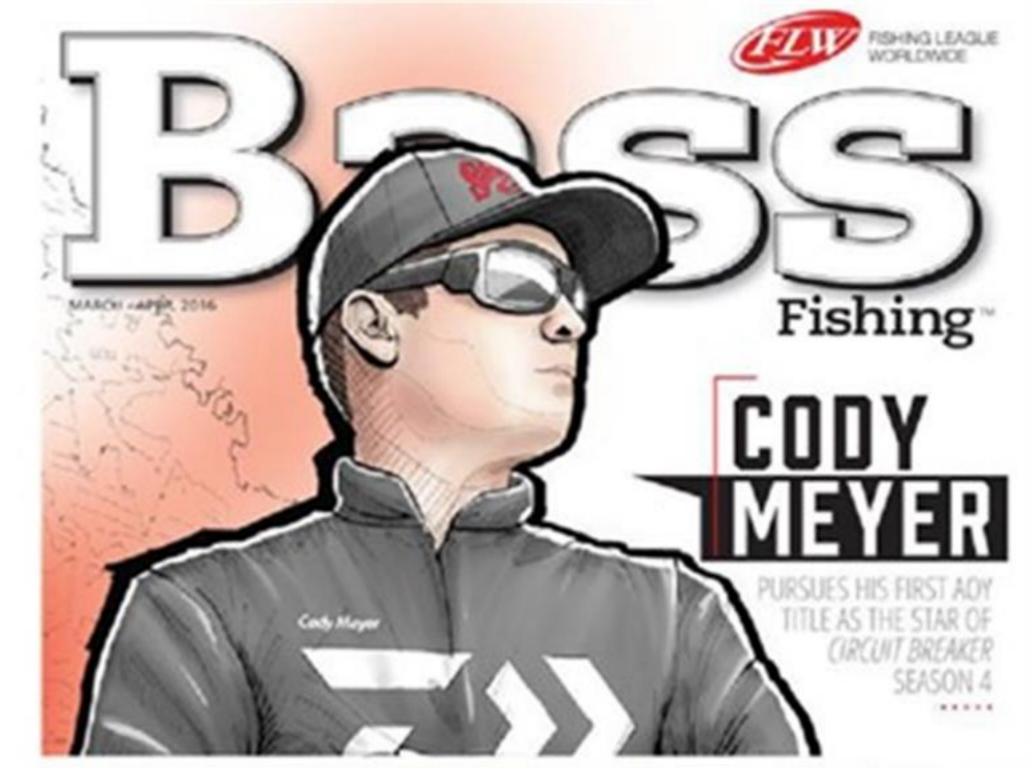

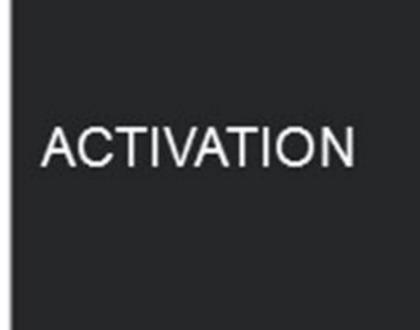
