The beautiful lakes of Alabama and the forests that surround them provide excellent recreational opportunities including boating, fishing, camping, hunting, sightseeing, hiking and much more. Bisecting Alabama's Black Prairie Belt, the William Dannelly Reservoir encompasses 105 miles of the Alabama River. Dannelly Reservoir is very appealing to sportsmen, birders, naturalists and those who just want to get away from it all. Claiborne Lake is the most primitive of the Alabama River lakes. Nestled in Alabama's southwest hill country, the lake encompasses over 60 miles of the Alabama River and offers extensive opportunities for water-related recreation. The Black Warrior and Tombigbee Lakes consist of six lakes with a combined total length of 457 miles and 39,800 acres of water for boaters to enjoy. The Tenn-Tom Waterway is an outdoor enthusiasts' paradise.
