SUBJECT: Changes to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Sign Standards Program

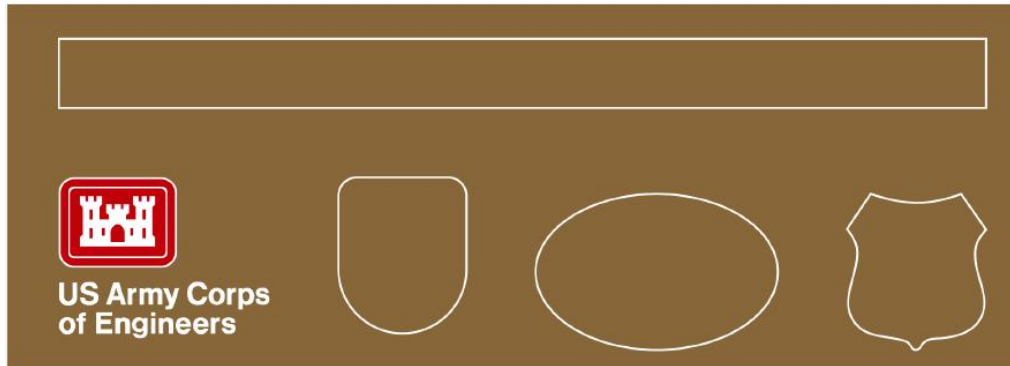
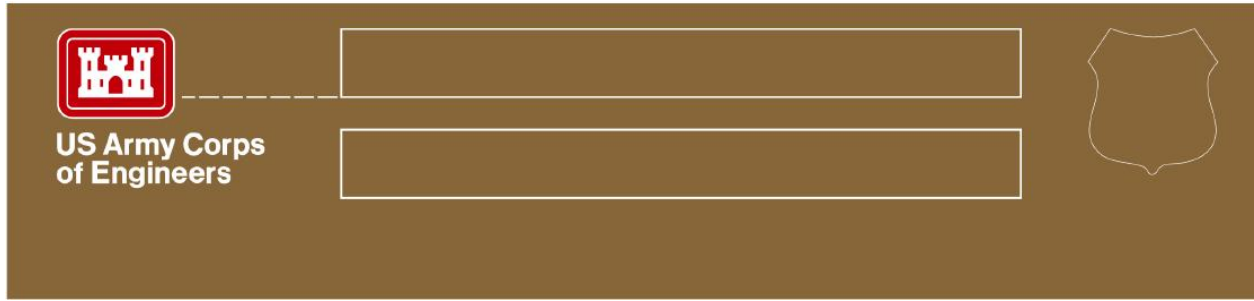
