**SUBJECT: Review of Engineer Regulation/Engineer Pamphlet 1130-2-550, Chapter 8,
Uniforms for Natural Resources Management Uniform Program Staff**

1. Enclosed for your review and comment is a draft copy of ER/EP 1130-2-550, Chapter 8, Uniforms for Natural Resources Management (NRM) Program Staff.
2. The NRM Uniform Regulation has not received a major revision since 2002. The NRM Uniform Committee has devoted considerable time in revising the regulation and I strongly recommend a full review by each office.
3. The draft document redefines the classes of uniforms, establishes changes in uniform wear restrictions, introduces new personal appearance standards, and addresses other modifications as stated in the enclosed Change Summary document. Please note that the enclosed Appendix L to the EP does not contain the graphics due to document size limitations. Refer to <ftp://ftp.usace.army.mil/usace/nwp/> to view Appendix L with the graphics.
