MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDERS, MAJOR SUBORDINATE COMMANDS; CHIEFS,
OPERATIONS DIVISIONS

SUBJECT: Day Use Fee Waived on Veterans Day, 11 November 2010

1. This memorandum reiterates the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Fee Free Day on Veterans Day, 11 November 2010. This initiative was first instituted in 2006 with the intent to support and honor the men and women who have served the Nation in the armed services.
2. Accordingly, all day use fees for veterans, active duty service members and their families visiting Corps-managed recreation areas will be waived on Veterans Day. However, fees for camping and camping related services will *not* be waived, and neither will fees for specialized facilities, such as group picnic shelters.
3. Other agencies that manage recreation areas located on Corps lands are encouraged (but not required) to comply with this Veterans Day waiver of fees in the areas that they manage.
4. I give you my full support to use the trust system on Veterans Day to acknowledge veterans, active duty service members, and their families as they enter the park. Verification will simply be accepted by verbal confirmation.
5. Please note that the attached memo dated 16 July 2010, SUBJECT: Theater of Operation Name Change: Global War on Terror to Overseas Contingency Operations. Recreations Day Use Fee and Camping Fee Waiver for Active Service Personnel and DoD Civilians, remains in effect.
