MEMORANDUM FOR Division and District Chiefs of Operations

SUBJECT: Signs on Jetties, Groins and Breakwaters

- 1. Reference: Sign Standards Manual, EP 310-1-6a, revised 2006.
- 2. In the 2006 revision, the wording "Proceed at Your Own Risk" was removed from use in the Sign Standards Program. The two signs with this language were WWA-20 and WWA-33, shown below.

- 3. If these two signs are still in use, they must be removed and a management decision made on whether site conditions remain such that a replacement sign is necessary. Replacement options include:
 - a. Page 14-48:
 - (1) Danger/Restricted Area Keep Out (WDA-24)
 - (2) Danger/Restricted Area Keep Off (WDA-25)
 - (3) Restricted Area/Water Levels Change Rapidly Walkway Subject to Sudden Flooding (WRE-24)
 - b. Page 14-52:
 - (1) Deadly Waves at Any Time (HS-001 symbol only)
 - (2) Deadly Waves at Any Time with symbol (HSLAT-01)
 - (3) Jetty Unsafe for Walking (HS-002 symbol only)
 - (4) Jetty Unsafe for Walking with symbol (HSLAT-02)

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The choice of signs is determined based upon local conditions. For assistance, contact your district sign program manager.
