SUBJECT: Request for Nominations - Natural Resources Management (NRM) Park Ranger
Community of Practice (CoP) Advisory Board

1. Last August, I released the NRM Park Ranger CoP Advisory Board's revised Charter which outlined the Board's new membership structure to include two Park Rangers from each Major Subordinate Command (MSC) (Enclosure 1). This action will require any MSC-level representatives and National Program Managers/Committee Chairs to rotate off of the Board.
2. The current membership will remain in place until the new membership structure becomes effective on 1 February 2012. In the interim, I'm requesting each MSC to begin the process of selecting its representative(s) to fill their respective vacant position(s) on the Board. The new membership roster (Enclosure 2) indicates the positions that will be vacant as of 1 January 2012.
3. Each MSC should provide the application package for their representative(s) to Mr. Freddie Bell, Advisory Board Chair, no later than 15 January 2012. An application questionnaire is provided for use in your request for nominations (Enclosure 3).
