SUBJECT: Changes to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Sign Standards Program

- 1. Upon the recommendation of the Sign Advisory Work Group and the National Sign Program Manager, a new symbol sign has been added to the U.S.Army Corps of Engineers Sign Program. The new prohibition symbol will be added to the next revision of the Sign Standards Manual, EP310-1-6a and 6b, to the Corps SignPro software, and posted on the NRM Gateway.
- 2. The new symbol is: PS-162, No Diving or Jumping.
