MEMORANDUM FOR CHIEFS, OPERATIONS, MAJOR SUBORDINATE COMMANDS AND
DISTRICT COMMANDS

SUBJECT: Modification of Standard Identification Signs to Include Army Star Logo

1. References:

a. EP 310-1-6a, *Sign Standards Manual*, Section 5.

b. *Placing Army Star Logo Decals onto Standard ID and Construction ID Signs*, dated 20190925 (updated 20191008), <https://corpslakes.erd.c.dren.mil/employees/sign/sign.cfm>.

2. The format for the Standard Identification (Standard ID) sign is now modified to include the Army star logo. This change places the Army star logo on the sign's right margin. New and replacement Standard ID signs will incorporate this standard.

3. All currently standing Standard ID signs will be assessed for their eligibility for Army star logo decal placement, as detailed in Reference 1b above. Eligible signs will receive decals. Signs ineligible for decals will not receive them but will be allowed to remain standing until the end of serviceable life. The Army star logo is not to be placed on the Individual Letterforms Standard Identification sign (STANIN) found on page 5-7 of the *Sign Standards Manual*.

4. The catalog code for the new Standard ID sign with the Army star is STANST. However, until Corps SignPro is updated to include the new sign type, Sign Program Managers (SPMs) will use the Corps Identification Sign with Partner Logo (PTNR) template found on pages 5-24 and 5-25 of the *Sign Standards Manual* to create orders. SPMs will specify the need for the Army star logo in the notes portion of their order sheets.

5. This change is effective immediately. Guidance in this memorandum will be integrated into the next publication of the *Sign Standards Manual*.

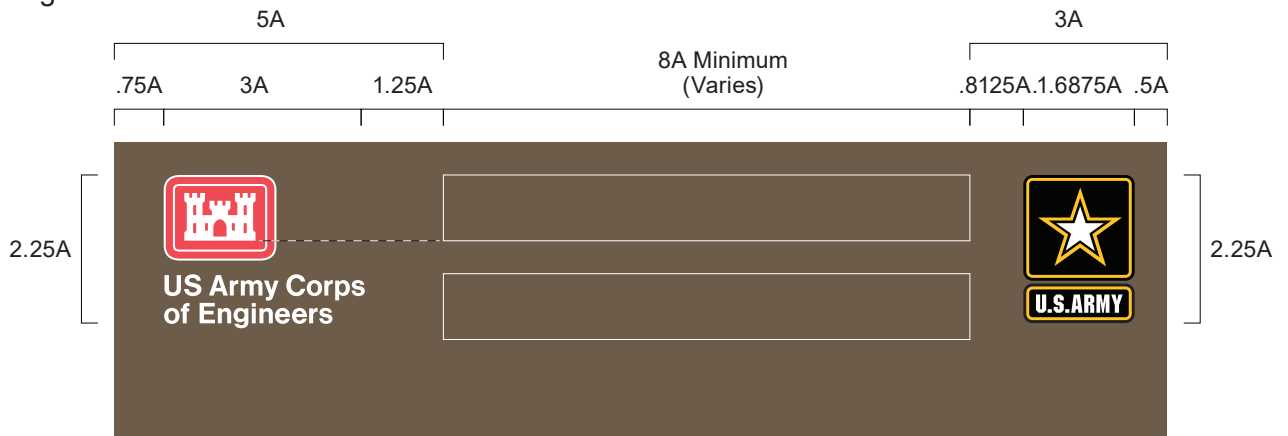

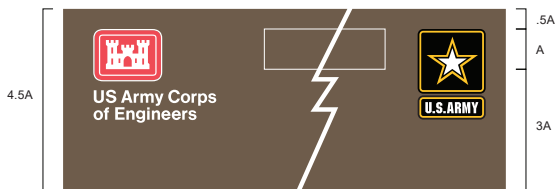
Enclosure 1: Modified Grid Schematics for STANST (Standard ID Signs with Army Star Logo)

This is a modification of page 5-25 of the *Sign Standards Manual*, adopting the Corps Identification Sign with Partner Logo grid (PTNR).

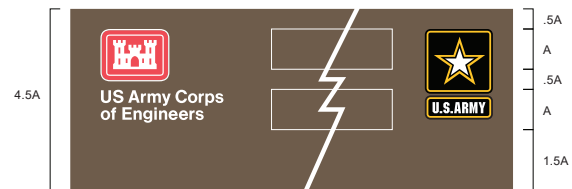
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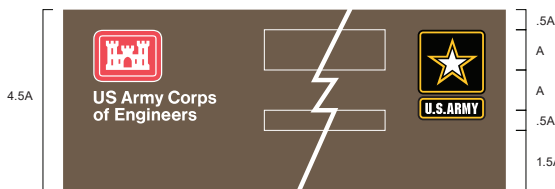
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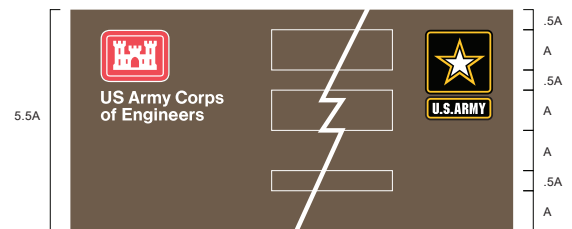
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One line, primary legend
(No Secondary Legend)



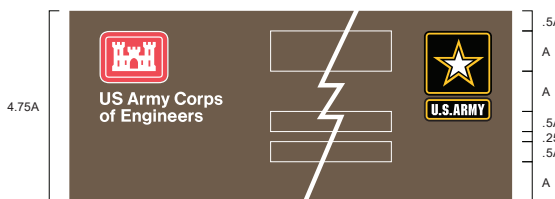
Grid 2-0

(No Secondary Legend)



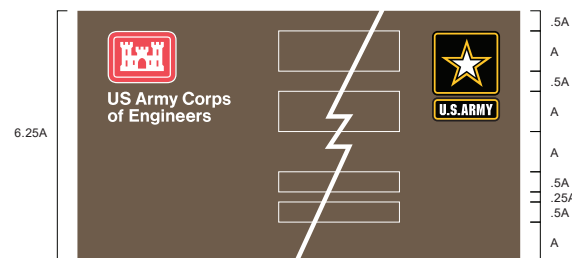
Grid 1-1
