SUBJECT: Handshake Partnership Program – Fiscal Year 2021 Recipients

- 1. I am pleased to announce the recipients for the fiscal year (FY) 2021 Handshake Partnership Program funding. These outstanding partnerships demonstrate the efforts and successes of our field projects in working with stakeholders to foster their involvement in improving and protecting our parks and natural resources. This initiative supports U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) efforts in being a community partner and working on grassroots partnering projects.
- 2. The enclosed list of the FY 2021 Handshake recipients is diverse in both geographic area and in project ideas. Thirteen projects have been funded that span eleven Corps districts within six divisions.
- 3. The funded projects involve 55 partners who have pledged more than \$731,000, (63%) of the \$1,158,000 to be invested in these projects. There are four first time recipients and seven projects where the partner is funding at least half of the total project cost. Collectively, these projects will improve recreational opportunities and facilities for all visitors, providing access for land and water-based recreation, connecting communities to outdoor opportunities, protecting and conserving natural resources, enhancing our environmental stewardship mission, increasing public awareness of the value of water resources, and engaging federal, state and local partners in a shared vision. We are very proud of the Corps team members and our valued partners!
