MEMORANDUM FOR MAJOR SUBORDINATE COMMANDERS, DISTRICT COMMANDERS AND CHIEFS OF OPERATIONS

SUBJECT: 2021 Water Safety Message to Commanders

- 1. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) remains strongly committed to reducing public recreation accidents and fatalities. Our park rangers and managers do an outstanding job in protecting our visitors by providing safety education, guidance, and enforcement. During the COVID-19 pandemic, they have worked tirelessly to keep themselves and our visitors safe. I thank them for their efforts.
- 2. As we enter the primary recreation season with an expectation of continued increasing visitation, I ask that you reinforce our attention to water safety. In FY 2020, we experienced 167 public recreation fatalities. Regarding fatalities, over the past ten years, 88 percent were male, 85 percent were over the age of 18, and 89 percent were not wearing a life jacket. One life lost is too many, so stay persistent when delivering water safety messages to our visitors and work as one team supporting to reduce the number of fatalities on our waterways.
- 3. The "Life Jackets Worn...Nobody Mourns" campaign developed by the USACE National Operations Center for Water Safety in cooperation with the Corps of Engineers Natural Resources Education Foundation focuses our water safety program on the high-risk population of adult men. 
