“Planning And Access: Outdoor Environments And Interpretive Opportunities” is an introduction to the latest information on outdoor recreation, including the U.S. Access Board’s Final Report On Outdoor Developed Areas, Recreation Facilities Notice Of Proposed Rule [and](#) current status of the guidelines.

This course will be of benefit to site managers, landscape architects, facility managers, accessibility coordinators, program planners, and anyone else who may have outdoor planning or management responsibilities.

The first day of the training program will be a required “Disability Awareness Seminar” that will introduce the course participants to information about people with visual impairments, people who are deaf or hard of hearing, people with physical impairments and people with other disabilities.

***Prerequisite:**

The prerequisite seminar is mandatory for all participants who have not attended a NCA core course or NCA disability awareness seminar in the last 3 years.
