American Land Conservation Award

The Catto Charitable Foundation established the American Land Conservation Award in 1996 to recognize outstanding volunteer leadership in land and water conservation.

The Award honors a volunteer conservationist for his or her outstanding individual leadership and distinguished service to preserving and protecting the nation's natural and historic resources for the benefit of their communities and future generations.

Recipients of the Award are recognized for building partnerships that lead to the preservation of open space, wildlife habitat, and sites that preserve a sense of place. Recipients are honored for their work to protect coastlines, river corridors, forestlands, farmland, rangeland, and historic sites.

The Prize

As the nation's largest prize to a volunteer in conservation, the Award's \$50,000 prize is administered by The Conservation Fund and presented to a citizen conservationist by the Catto Charitable Foundation.

Applications may be submitted from January 1 to July 21 of each year. The 2004 award will be announced at the Land Trust Alliance Rally, held in Providence, Rhode Island, October 28-31.
