


The importance of educational outreach in risk management



Note: -1971 Enactment of the Federal Boat Safety Act, the U.S. Coast Guard and the States began working within the forum of NASBLA, (National Association of Boating Law Administrators).

- -1986 The Corps began promoting water safety nationwide through an annual, unified safety education campaign.
- -1994 National Operations Center (NOC) for Water Safety established
- -1998 NOC began quantifying public fatality data













FY98-16 Fatalities by Month






FY98-16 Fatalities by Day





FY98-16 Time of Fatalities







