

Aquatic Invasive Species Sailboat Art



The Lake Champlain Basin Program worked with the Burlington Community Sailing Center on Lake Champlain to support a local artist design of aquatic invasive species that would be printed on a sailboat sail and will be flown on a sailboat on the Burlington waterfront for the next three years.

A local Burlingtonian artist was selected, Nikki Lazar, and she created this stunning black and white piece that was printed on the sail. The mussels in the center represent zebra mussels, surrounded by sea lamprey mouths, strands of Eurasian watermilfoil and alewife, which have a landlocked population in Lake Champlain.
