Who: Environmental Stewardship Content Development SME's for selected programs. Various NRM Gateway working group members will attend as facilitators.

When: 21-24 July 2003. Meeting shall start at 8 a.m. on the 21th and end by 5 p.m. on the 24th.

Where: The Inn at Keystone is located at the Keystone Resort, Keystone, Colorado approximately 90 minutes drive from Denver International Airport. Exit the airport on Pena Boulevard to I-70 West and stay there for about 80 miles. Go through the almost two-mile long Eisenhower tunnel. Exit the tunnel and go approximately 6 miles to exit 205 (Silverthorne-Dillon). Turn left at the end of exit ramp onto Highway 6. You will be traveling east on Hwy 6 for approximately 10 miles. Just after mile marker 216, take a right on Rasor Drive then and immediate left. The Inn is a six story salmon colored hotel. Call the front desk at 970-468-1334 if you have any problems.

Meeting Room: Day 1 in Summit 3 and remainder of the week in Summit 2 Conference Room at the Inn. The conference room has projection capability and internet access; however, no computer is provided by the hotel.

Airport Transportation: If you do not wish to rent a car, a ground transportation to and from Denver International Airport is available through Resort Express (800-334-7433 or 303-334-7433) for \$53 one way or \$106 round trip using a ten-passenger van. The shuttle runs every 1 ½ hours from the airport, from 9:30 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. It runs from the resorts every 1 ½ hours from 5:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. The service takes about two hours each time.
