## BE ON THE LOOKOUT FOR ZEBRA MUSSELS



Zebra Mussels vary from 1/8 to 2 inches long and have a yellow-brown shell with alternating color bands. This mussel is prolific and can form colonies of thousands on your boat or any submerged hard surface

## TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO YOUR BOAT OR TRANSPORTATION TO NON INFESTED WATER, PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES.

- Pull all plugs and drain all water including the bilge, live well, motor and bait buckets.
- Inspect the boat and trailer for attached Zebra Mussels.
- Scrape off any Zebra Mussels and remove all vegetation, mud or other debris.
- Dry boat and trailer for 1 week, opening all compartments and areas where there may be moisture, before entering another waterway.

Wash boat, motor and trailer with high pressure, hot (140°F) water, (most car wash facilities will suffice). Finish with a clean water rinse. Do not wash at the ramp.
