


TU's Evolution






Pre-1990's: Local, in-stream projects




1990's: Full watershed scale projects

Results





- \triangleright \$60k = \$737k in match & leverage
- ➤ 36,000 LF of livestock fencing
- ➤ 140 acres of riparian buffer restored
- 29 acres of wetlands restored
- > 16 stream miles reconnected
- > 12 miles of stream habitat restored
- > 775 tons of sediment removed per year
- ➤ Total of 1.5 million ft. fencing = 284 miles (PFW)



Results





- \$275k = \$4.2m in match & leverage
- More than 100 miles of spring creek restoration over the past decade
- TU is currently restoring about 12-16 miles each year
- ➤ 30 miles of fishing access easements since 2014

Results



- > \$25k = \$528k in match & leverage
- > Removal of Spread Ck. dam
- Regrade stream channel for natural flow/habitat
- Install three weirs for diversion
- Modernize irrigation infrastructure
- Open 45 miles of habitat to Snake River cutthroats
