### US Army Corps of Engineers

Environmental Compliance Coordinator Network (ECC NETWORK)

- Each Division, District, Project & Laboratory
- ECC's administer the program at the field level
- ECC's coordinate with other Corps elements



# US Army Corps Environmental Compliance Assessments of Engineers

- The acronym, ERGO, has become synonymous with the assessment process
- ERGO is the Environmental Review Guide for Operations. Corps specific tool used to conduct environmental compliance assessments
- Other tools used to conduct assessments are the TEAM Guide & State Supplements

### US Army Corps Environmental Compliance Assessments of Engineers

- · Five year Cycle
  - External every five years
  - Internal every year except year for external
- Cycle I Completed FY 94
- Cycle II Completed FY 99
- Cycle III Program Underway (FY 00 04)



### Environmental Compliance Assessments Outgrants

- Seek to conduct assessments CONCURRENT with Real Estate compliance inspections to limit impact on leasee (When not possible RE representative requested to participate)
- ER 200-2-3 requires that external assessments be conducted at Major outgrants
- Districts decide if internal assessments of outgrants are needed
- Correction of deficiencies on Outgrants is the responsibility of outgrantee/leasee

## Environmental Compliance Assessments Outgrants

- Inconsistency exist both in completion of assessments at outgrants & follow-up on deficiencies
- Proposed SOP to formalize responsibilities in conducting environmental compliance assessments & follow-up actions
- EIG report cited need to improve outgrant environmental compliance

### US Army Corps Proposed SOP For Outgrant Assessments of Engineers

- Procedures for conducting External assessments
- Annually develop schedule/list of Outgrants to be assessed
- Notification to outgrants of assessment
  - request to attend
  - pre-visit questionnaire
- Reporting Findings to outgrants
  - verbally exit briefing
  - written
- Corrective Action Follow-up
- OMBIL data entry

#### **Budget**

- No separate environmental Appropriation/Fund
- No separate HTRW clean-up fund
- Environmental compliance projects are included in the Operations and Maintenance budget, compete for resources with other projects

#### USACE Environmental Operating Principles

- Strive to achieve Environmental Sustainability. An environment maintained in a healthy, diverse, and sustainable condition is necessary to support life.
- 2. Recognize the interdependence of life and the physical environment. Proactively consider environmental consequences of Corps programs and act accordingly in all appropriate circumstances.
- 3. Seek balance and synergy among human development activities and natural systems by designing economic and environmental solutions that support and reinforce one another.
- 4. Continue to accept corporate responsibility and accountability under the law for activities and decisions under our control that impact human health and welfare and the continued viability of natural systems.



#### USACE Environmental Operating Principles

- 5. Seek ways and means to assess and mitigate cumulative impacts to the environ-ment; bring systems approaches to the full life cycle of our processes and work.
- 6. Build and share an integrated scientific, economic & social knowledge base that supports a greater understanding of the environment and impacts of our work.
- 7. Respect the views of individuals and groups interested in Corps activities; listen to them actively and learn from their perspective in the search to find innovative win-win solutions to the Nation's problems that also protect and enhance the environment

Principle #4: Continue to accept corporate responsibility and accountability under the law for activities and decisions under our control that impact human health and welfare and the continued viability of natural systems.

- Focus on compliance with Nation's environmental laws and mandates in our mission execution
- Apply responsibility and accountability in <u>all</u> aspects of our work (administrative, technical, scientific, managerial) and ensure everything we do meets or exceeds legal requirements
- Responsibility and Accountability mean:
  - Understanding importance of achieving sustainability
  - Setting expectations for changes in individual and corporate behavior
  - Setting clear objectives for every project and activity, and
  - Providing sound indicators to report achievements



#### Principle #4 Example

- Environmental Compliance at Projects, Labs, Centers and Facilities
  - Environmental Compliance Coordinator Network assures all USACE-operated facilities meet relevant environmental laws/regulations
  - · Requires annual assessments of facilities
  - Operations managers responsible/accountable for compliance, correcting deficiencies, reporting results
  - Integrated into day-to-day operations employees take pride in going beyond required standards
