SUBJECT: Lakeshore Management Plans

Division Engineer,

1. The Lakeshore Management Plans currently being prepared in accordance with the guidance provided by ER 1130-2-406, subject: Lakeshore Management at Civil Works Projects, dated 13 December 1974, have generated intense adverse reaction in certain parts of the country. Such reaction has not been limited to owners of affected floating facilities, but has come also from individuals and groups not directly affected by the lakeshore management program.
2. The District Engineers should contact each permit holder by either letter or visit to establish a one-on-one relationship between the Corps and the owners. The establishment of such a relationship will permit both the Corps and the permit holder to develop an objective appreciation of lakeshore management, its necessity, its problems, and the responsibility of both parties to make it work.
3. Each District Engineer should formulate a plan of action and establish a date for contacting all permittees individually prior to the public meeting on lakeshore management plans on each project.
