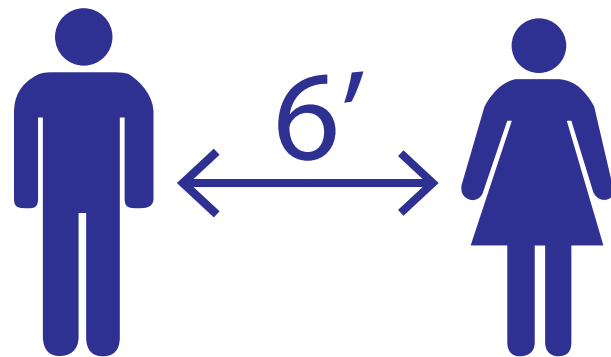

## **Masks and Social Distancing Required**

**Masks are mandatory:**

- a. Inside all buildings**
- b. Outdoors when social distancing (6 feet) is not maintained**

**Per CDC Guidelines and 36 CFR §327.12(a)**

## Sign Placement and Mounting Guidelines

### Guidance:

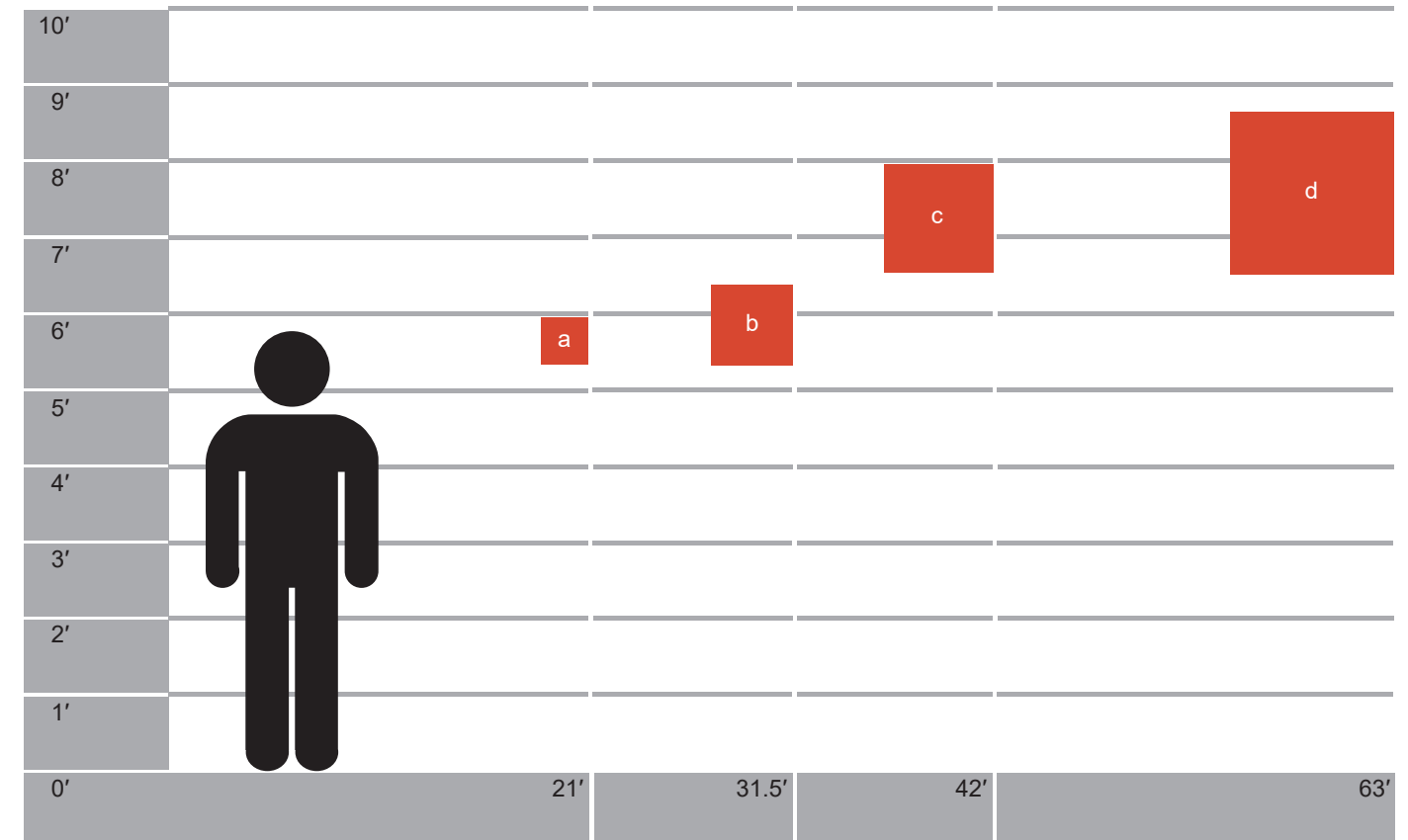
- The face mask sign is designed by default to be 8"x12" (2:3 ratio) for optimal minimum visibility. However, it may be scaled larger or smaller (depending on your site's specific needs and unusual space limitations), provided the 2:3 ratio is maintained. A sign is only effective if it is easily read.
- Use Sign Placement and Mounting Guidelines from page 11-11 in the *Sign Standards Manual*, EP 310-1-6a (also pictured to the right). The 8"x12" face mask sign counts as *Panel A* in the example (even though *Panel A* is actually an 8"x8" sign).
- For this specific sign, reproduction onto any medium is authorized (plastic, aluminum, printed and laminated, etc.) as long as it remains professional in appearance.
- The dimensions of this document are 11"x17" and will not easily print on 8.5"x11" paper.

Sign size and placement should be natural and intuitive. They are placed to alert and inform in sufficient time to avoid a given hazard or take appropriate action. They should be sized for easy reading from the viewing distance required. In visually complex industrial shops, signs that are too small are lost while overly large signs can overwhelm an area.

Effectively place signs where they will not create distractions. Avoid grouping too many signs together in one location. Small sign panels placed for close viewing are appropriately placed at average eye level (with the bottom of the sign at 5' 4" or so). Larger signs posted in big spaces or for viewing at greater distances should be placed proportion-

ally higher. Signs should not be placed where moveable objects may obscure them. Only place those signs that relate to a specific piece of equipment on that equipment.

Before ordering a sign, place a cardboard panel in the proposed location to verify the size and placement location.



#### a) 8" x 8" Panel

Mounted at eye level (bottom of panel mounted at approximately 5' 4") for viewing up to 21 feet.

#### b) 12" x 12" Panel

Mounted at eye level (bottom of panel mounted at approximately 5' 4") for viewing up to 31.5 feet.

#### c) 16" x 16" panel

Mounted above eye level (bottom of panel mounted at approximately 6' 6" or higher) for viewing up to 42 feet.

#### d) 24" x 24" Panel

Mounted (bottom of panel mounted at approximately 6' 6" or higher) for viewing up to 63 feet.
