1. At Entrance to the Facility

A facility that charges fees must display the “U.S. Fee Area” symbol in one form or another. Pictured above are individual options that can be chosen from to meet this requirement. Amounts and legend entries on the ENT-05 may be customized. When using the Slat Panel option for the Fee Symbol, remember that 2–4 total panels are required in the installation.

2. Guiding Visitors to the Pay Station

In larger parking areas, it may be necessary to use one or more of these optional signs to guide visitors to the Pay Station. Place them high enough above the ground level to be seen over other parked vehicles.

3. At the Pay Station

The Pay Station sign should stand high enough from the ground level for people to be able to see over vehicles (usually 60 inches above ground level).

The Parking & Payment sign is placed at the Pay Station and/or at the entrance of the paid parking area. Its purpose is to instruct visitors how to pay for parking.
