The clothing industry has a lot of advanced technology in synthetic fabrics and materials, however we provide and require individuals to wear polyester while working in 100+ degree temperatures. I would like to have the cargo pants cut and comfort improved, remove GIANT waist band, and improve the fabric so the pants are breathable. Also, I would like the fabric to be improved on the work and duty shirts, neither are breathable.	1	No action taken.	While you make good points, you must consider all the ramifications involved with your proposals. The Corps owns the uniform items in stock with the contractor. Making sweeping wholesale changes to the uniform would require the Corps to "buy-out" those items and all the fabric purchased for their construction. This is further complicated by the restrictions of the Buy American and NAFTA acts. The committee is working with the contractor to provide the best possible uniforms within the requirements of the contract.
