## »»» VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ US citizen or legal alien (permanent resident) or foreign exchange student with J-1, J-2, or F-1 student visa.
- ▶ 18 years or older, or children with written parental/guardian consent.
- ▶ May need specific skills (Example: carpentry, GIS, computer skills, etc.), but is not necessary.
- ▶ Background checks may be required.
