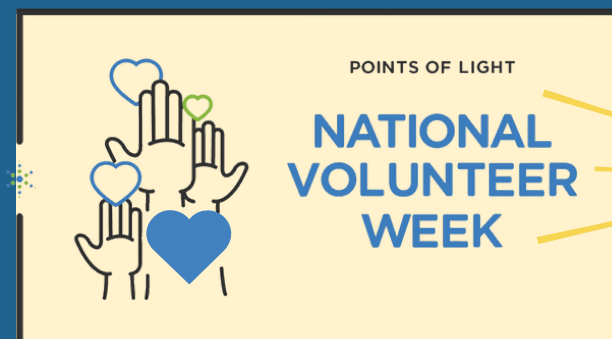




National Volunteer Week
