He has done a variety of work since starting his volunteer service in 2022, such as weekly inspections and maintenance of the lake's fee machines, life jacket loaner stands, and helping at the visitor center front desk operations. He assists other volunteers on the Allatoona recycling program and with the natural resource management program. He also removed blue lights, radios, sirens, and insignias off 12 patrol vehicles to be traded in last year. Curt has been able to complete several incredible projects at little or no cost to USACE. This includes volunteer and employee going away plaques, fee machine instructions in both English and Spanish, book libraries for campgrounds, volunteer magnets, Christmas ornaments, recreational signs and volunteer coins unique to the Allatoona Lake program. He completed 1,021 hours last year in addition to working full-time at another job.
