- **Low (green)**- Indoor mask-wear not required for DoD employees & visitors, however, may elect to wear a mask at any time.* Social distancing and room occupancy limits remains in effect.  
 - No COVID-19 screening program is required.*
 - *Commanders may implement a more rigorous testing & mask posture to protect employee health.
- **Medium (yellow)**- Indoor mask-wear not required for DoD employees and visitors.  
 - Must utilize a COVID-19 screening program.
- **High (orange)**- Indoor mask-wear is required for DoD employees and visitors.  
 - Must utilize a COVID-19 screening program.
- **Official visitors** not provided self-test kits; testing at own expense within 72-hours of entry.
- **Occupancy is defined by HPCON:**
 - A: <14 weekly cumulative cases per 100K = <100% occupancy
 - B: 14-109 weekly cumulative cases per 100K = <50% occupancy
 - B+: 110-210 weekly cumulative cases per 100K = <40% occupancy
 - C: 211-420 weekly cumulative cases per 100K = <25% occupancy
 - D: ≥421 weekly cumulative cases per 100K = <15% occupancy
