On September 21, 2021 at approximately 0730 hours, Stillhouse Hollow Lake Volunteer, Mr. James (Jimmy) McCue was summoned to the aid of another lake volunteer, Mr. Joe Benavidez by his girlfriend. Upon his arrival to the site of Mr. Benavidez, Mr. McCue quickly realized that Mr. Benavidez was unresponsive and immediately jumped into action performing life-saving CPR. Mr. McCue asked the girlfriend if 911 had been called, which she responded yes. Mr. McCue continued administering CPR until the paramedics arrived. Upon their arrival, Mr. Benavidez had regained a weak pulse, at which time the paramedics resumed rendering the necessary medical attention and transported Mr. Benavidez to the nearest hospital for further treatment. Mr. McCue's quick actions and training saved a life that day!
