Their volunteer services at River Road Park has allowed us to eliminated one contract for park attendant services saving the government thousands of dollars and allowing us to keep this park open since it was not performing well in the park assessment reviews. Their upbeat and jolly personalities have been a great benefit to the park and its visitors. Visitors may come into the park with a frown on their face or down in the dumps, but after talking to Mike and Bonnie for a while, they leave with a big smile, laughing, and in good spirits. Mike and Bonnie put in many more hours per week than is required of them and run the gate house and keep it open just like our paid contractors.
