smells like gross dead fish guts.




"Have you tried a new inflatable life jacket?" asked Ranger Buck. "They're more comfortable, and just as safe as an old style life jacket. Here, use this one."





Tackle was very happy to try out the inflatable life jacket. He thought it felt good and looked cool. But, he still wasn't happy about having to wear it.

Tackle was fishing from the deck of his little dog house boat, the Dogfish. "Gotcha," barked Tackle. He had hooked what must have been a monster fish.




"No one will out fish me!" boasted the world famous underwater explorer Jacques Catsto as he sailed by on his ship, the Catnipso.





The waves from the Catnipso and the tugging from the monster fish was enough to knock Tackle off balance. He tumbled head first into the water!
















When Tackle went underwater his inflatable life jacket deployed. Tackle popped to the surface, still gripping his fishing rod and fish.



The monster fish began to tow Tackle away from the Dogfish. If a fisherman ends up in the water it's safer for them to stay near their boat until rescued.



Bobber and the pups saw Tackle in distress and decided to run for help. Don't go in the water to help someone. It's best to go get help from an adult.



Bobber and the pups found Ranger Buck and told him about Tackle. Buck called out over his radio. "Buck to patrol, we have a fisherman in the water."



REACH

Hold onto a dock or boat and reach your hand or whatever is nearby to the person in the water.



THROW

If you can't reach far enough, toss something that floats for the person to grab.



POW

Paddle a boat closer to person or call out to a nearby boat for help. Never use the boat motor near a person in the water.




DON'T GO

Don't go into the water unless you're a trained lifeguard. Yell for help. Call 911. Learn CPR and first aid for drowning and hypothermia.

Today's Recipe WORM DIRI

These wormy pudding cups make a yummy dessert!





Ask an adult to help you with this recipe.



chocolate pudding chocolate sandwich cookies gummy worms candy 4 small bowls or cups







Step 1

Spoon chocolate pudding into cups. Fill the cups to within about an inch of the top edge. Depending on the size of your cups, one package of pudding should be enough for 4 cups of worm dirt.

Or, you can leave the pudding in snack cups.

Step 2

Pull apart sandwich cookies and remove filling. You don't need the filling for this recipe. Put cookies into a sandwich bag, seal the top, and then crush cookies into small pieces. Sprinkle crumbs all over the top of the pudding in the cups to look like dirt.

Step 3

Place gummy worms on top of the "dirt". Poke worms into "dirt" so it looks like they are popping out of the ground. Now grab some spoons because your Worm Dirt is ready to eat!

Salt Dough Recipe

You Will Need:

1/4 cup salt 1/2 cup flour 1/4 cup water Put salt and flour in a bowl. Stir in water slowly. If it is too dry add a little more water. Knead dough until it feels like play clay. Your dough is now ready to use. If needed you can keep it in refrigerator in a covered bowl until you are ready to use it.

To Make Lures

You Will Need:

salt dough • cookie sheet baking paper • paper clips brushes • paint • feathers* clear nail polish • glue* *optional

Fishing Fun Game

You Will Need:

long stick or yard stick string or yarn socks or paper fish sofa or bed

Step !

Roll dough into quarter size balls. Flatten the balls into 1/2 inch thick oval shapes. Place them on cookie sheet covered with baking paper. Bend paper clips into the shape shown below. Push the unbent end of the paper clip into one end of the dough and out the other.



Let lures dry for at least 24 hours or ask an adult to help you bake them in an oven for 2 hours on very low heat. Let lures cool on cookie sheet. When cool. color lures with paint. After the paint dries coat the lures with clear nail polish to protect the paint. If you would like to you can glue feathers to your lures.

Tie or tape string to the end of a stick. Have an adult cut the string the same length of the stick. Tie the loose end of the string to your lure. As with any fishing equipment always be careful not to swing it into yourself or others. Use a sofa or bed as your boat and try to pick up socks or paper fish off the floor. How many can you catch?

Pro Tip: Even play fishing is a good time to practice wearing a life jacket properly!






I'm a park ranger and a big part of my job is teaching folks how to be safe around water. Bobber is a big help with doing that.

Kids love Bobber! They often want to know when Bobber's birthday is.












When you adopt a pet they're often called a "rescue" pet. Bobber turned out to be a rescue dog in more ways than one.

One day, Tackle was fishing on Waterbowl Lake and wouldn't you know it, he fell overboard!




Good thing he had his life jacket on because his boat drifted away from him.
