Boating & Water Safety Strategic Campaign Plan

Typical victim: <u>Middle-aged male</u> who drowned while swimming in a <u>non-designated area</u>; <u>no life</u> jacket worn, <u>alcohol/drugs NOT</u> involved.

Males = 89%
Drowning = 86%
No life jacket worn = 92%
Non-designated area = 81% (known swimming incidents)
Alcohol or drugs = 22%

Based on recorded data from FY 1998-2007

Key Messages for Children

 Make sure adults are watching you Always swim with a buddy Learn to swim well Don't depend on inflatables toys Wearing a life jacket can be fun Never dive into water head first Know 4 signs of drowning victim Reach, throw, row, go for help

Key Messages for Teenagers/Adults

.Know your limits Watch your children •Wear it (10 min. vs 60 sec.) •File a float plan •Beware of boater's hypnosis Know before you go Alcohol & water don't mix Your involuntary gasp reflex can kill Cold water immersion-HELP response Take a boating safety course Beware of CO poisoning risks Boat with consideration for others Steer clear of commercial vessels Inspect your equipment
