The PFD Song (Round)

Part 1

1 PFD, 2 PFD, 3 PFD, 4 PFD, 5 PFD, 6 PFD Put your PFD on (Act like you are zipping or buckling up a life jacket)

Part 2 (rocking motion)

Don't rock the boat while I'm in it, I'm in it, I'm in it Don't rock the boat

Part 3

I swim with a buddy, buddy, buddy, I swim with a buddy, Never, never alone (find a buddy and hold hands with them)

Row, Row, Row Your Boat with a Water Safety Message

Substitute "Wear Your PFD" for "Life is but a dream" and sing in rounds
