Park Rangers George Harchack and Shane Riley held a "Chalk the Walk" event at Mud Mountain Dam Park sponsored by the Corps Foundation on Kids to Parks Day. The Corps Foundation provided the funds to purchase the chalk for the public to use for the event and prizes for the winners. Five volunteers assisted with setup and registration for the event, as well as handing out water safety goodie bags. Overall, 7 children participated in the event with about 50 water safety contacts including family of the participants and other visitors to the park.
