Summary:

During the month of August 2024, PORPA and LBS provided free water safety lessons at Riley Creek Recreation Area for families in the local community. During the water safety lessons, local children ages 1-17 from Bonner County learned how to swim and play in the water safely from certified instructors. Over 200 children participated in the program, doubling participation from 2023. Students also participated in a water safety program from Park Ranger staff on their last day of lessons and received giveaways as part of their graduation.
