SCOPE OF WORK USACE/FWS ENDANGERED SPECIES OUTREACH AND EDUCATION FUNDING **BETWEEN THE** ST. LOUIS DISTRICT, U.S. CORPS OF ENGINEERS (USACE) **AND THE U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE MISSOURI ECOLOGICAL SERVICES FIELD OFFICE (MOFO)**

1. Background:

Funding will be used to create short educational videos featuring federally endangered or threatened species in Missouri. The purpose of the videos will be to educate the general public on the natural history of the species (appearance, habitats used), reasons for decline, actions federal and state agencies (FWS, USACE, others) are taking to help species recover, and what Missourians can do to assist in species recovery (e.g. not contaminate water sources where fish live). The videos will be shared freely on social media platforms (e.g. Facebook), and available for use on agency and partner websites, or as educational materials for schools and various education and outreach groups. If there is enough funding left over once videos are produced, MOFO may work with a social media marketing specialist to increase Missouri resident exposure to the videos.

The candidate species covered are Big Creek Crayfish, St. Francis River Crayfish, the Little Brown Bat, the Tricolored Bat, and Northern Long-eared Bat, Scaleshell mussel, and Mead's Milkweed . If funding allows, we may focus on more range restricted species such as the Grotto Sculpin, Hine's Emerald Dragonfly, or the Missouri Bladderpod. The number of species covered will depend on the cost per species video and the amount of work that will be required of each MOFO biologist to put together necessary information.

- 2. Authority: Economy Act of 1933
- 3. Description of Services:

The USACE will provide the following:

a. Collaboration with USFWS on which species the video will highlight.

The USFWS will provide the following:

- a. compile/prepare species information for the video,
- b. collaborate with participating partners for scheduling a site visit or assisting with any species expert or agency interviews,
 c. complete up to three rounds of site visits to record footage,
- d. provide guidance during video editing, and
- e. social media dissemination as funds permit.
- 4. Obligation/Reimbursement of Funds: The USFWS will provide the above described services to the USACE at a total cost of \$31,000 (Table 1). The funding will be provided in one payment on MIPR number W81C8X22446169

5. Clauses/Statements:

Effective Date: This agreement is effective beginning 11-30-2022 and it will remain in effect through 11-29-2023.

Termination/Cancellation: Either agency may terminate this instrument in whole or in part, in writing, at any time before the date of expiration upon 30 days written notice of such termination. Neither party may incur any new obligations for the terminated portion of the Inter/Intra-Agency Agreement (IAA) after the effective date and must cancel as many obligations as possible. Full credit must be allowable for each party's expense and all obligations that cannot be cancelled, but were properly incurred, up to the effective date of termination.

Modification and Indirect Rates: This agreement may be modified with mutual concert of both parties in writing at any time. We review our indirect cost recovery rates every 2 years (see 264 FW 1). If this agreement is extended by a modification the indirect rate may change.

Method for Settlement of Disputes: lin the event of a dispute between the parties, USFWS and the USACE shall use their best efforts to resolve that dispute in an informal fashion through consultation and communication, or other forms of non-binding alternative dispute resolution. The parties agree that, in the event such measures fail to resolve the dispute, they shall refer it for resolution to the Office of Management and Budget.

The D&F finds that the use of an interagency acquisition is in the best interest of the government and that the services cannot be obtained as conveniently or economically by contracting directly with a private source.

Determination and Findings

Economy Act Order

SUBJECT: U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS), Endangered Species Education for U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) properties located in the St. Louis District (MVS) Area of Responsibility (AOR) in the State of Missouri.

1. References.

- a. DoDI 4000.19, December 2020, subject: Support Agreements.
- b. DoD 7000.14-R, Vol. 11A, Chapter 3, September 2019, subject: Economy Act Orders.

2. Authority. The Economy Act (31 U.S.C. § 1535) authorizes agencies to enter into agreements to obtain supplies or services from another agency. It applies when more specific statutory authority doesnot exist.

3. Purpose. This Determination and Findings (D&F) documents that use of an Economy Act, by USACE, to provide endangered species education for USACE properties located in the USACE MVS AOR in the State of Missouri, by FWS, is in the best interests of the Government.

4. Requirement Information.

a. Description of services: Work shall include, but is not limited to creating short educational videos featuring endangered species at USACE properties located in the USACE MVS AOR in the State of Missouri.

- b. Servicing Agency: U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service
- c. Requesting Agency: U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, St. Louis District (MVS)

5. The proposed use of an inter-agency transaction is in the best interest of the Government considering the following factors:

- a. Funding is available to pay for the support.
 - (1) The work is currently estimated to cost \$31,000.00.
- b. The servicing agency can provide the support.
 - (1) Work shall include creating short educational videos featuring endangered species.
- c. The transaction does not conflict with any other agency's authority or responsibility.

d. The supplies or services cannot be obtained as conveniently or economically by contracting directly with a private source.

(1) FWS has performed similar work at USACE properties in previous years. As a result, FWS is very familiar with the conditions that exist. Our staff has an excellent working relationshipwith FWS personnel and FWS has the capability and expertise required to accomplish this work. Accordingly, the services cannot be provided within the time required and more economically by contractors under an Army contract.

(2) The FWS expertise qualifies their personnel to provide a very costeffective means to develop and produce quality educational videos in support of the USACE environmental stewardship mission. For FY23, this effort will cost approximately \$31,000. Similar efforts by a private contractor would cost approximately \$41,000 including labor (120 hours x \$194.15 per/hr for a Video Producer) and production (\$18,445 for a six-minute video). In addition, the cost and time it would take to administer and secure a contract would exceed the timeframe that the funds need to be expended in. Lowest Price Technically Acceptable contract which could take up to 120 days to award. At that point, the funds would no longer be available. The labor cost for the Government to award and administer the contract would far exceed the cost of the agreement. Ultimately, using a private contractor would exceed the costs of the entire agreement and would not be completed in the timeframe required, negatively impacting the USACE environmental stewardship mission at Wappapello Lake.

e. Other applicable considerations:

(1) FWS has unique expertise or ability that is not available within the DoD and they have substantial experience required for performing this work. The FWS regularly performs this type of work, and will accept the order, and can satisfy the requirement.

(2) FWS has informed the St. Louis District that it has the capability and capacity to provide these goods and services.

6. Additional Information and Documentation:

a. A copy of the approved D&F will be provided to the non-DoD agency along with the Economy Act order.

b. In accordance with reference 1.a, a FS Form 7600A is attached (Enclosure 1) that specifies the roles and responsibilities of the parties and specifies the services to be acquired.

c. This D&F will serve for the above-described work on USACE properties up to the estimated aggregate cost of \$31,000.00. Based on the availability of funds, task order(s), along with corresponding documents, will be forwarded to the Mississippi Valley Division Commander for certification that funding is available to pay for support under such additional task order(s).

d. Funds will be certified for each task order.

7. Based on the above findings, I determine that:

a. Funding will be available for each approved Task Order;

b. The servicing agency is able to provide the support;

c. The transaction does not conflict with any other agency's authority;

d. The supplies or services cannot be obtained as conveniently or economically by contracting directly with a private source;

e. Use of an inter-agency acquisition is in the best interests of the Government.
