

## ECONOMY ACT ORDER 2009-1 FOR SERVICES AND/OR SUPPLIES

Reference: Memorandum of Agreement of 2009 between the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Portland District and the Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management, Eugene District, for the negotiation of reimbursable work projects under the Economy Act (31 USC 1535).

Requesting Agency: US Army Corps of Engineers, Portland District

Servicing Agency: Bureau of Land Management, Eugene District

### Scope of Work:

The tasks identified for FY 2009 are associated with the prescribed burning of a native wetland prairie and emergent grasses located along the eastern shoreline of Fern Ridge Lake. These lands are administered by the Corps of Engineers and each unit is described as follows:

#### USACE Unit 1 Royal Amazon T17S R5W S23 E $\frac{1}{2}$ and S24 NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Located N of Royal Avenue and S of the Amazon Canal at the E margin of Fern Ridge Reservoir. The unit is approximately 120 acres comprised of light grass and forb fuels with a small component of woody species such as exotic blackberry and Douglas spiraea. The objective of the burn is to suppress woody plant invasion and enhance the native prairie community including the Federally listed *Lomatium bradshawii*. This unit was last burned in 2002.

#### USACE Unit 2 Fisher Butte T17S R5W S26 SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and S35 NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$

Located on the south side of Fisher Butte and north of Highway 126. The unit is approximately 70 acres comprised of native prairie fuels made up of grasses and forbs. A woody shrub component is scattered through the unit. The objective of the burn is to enhance the native prairie plant community including the federally listed *Lomatium bradshawii* and *Erigeron decumbens* by controlling encroachment of woody vegetation which threatens the native plant community. This unit was last burned in 2005.

### **The Corps of Engineers, Willamette Valley Projects will:**

1. Designate a staff member to serve as a Resource Advisor in the planning and implementation of the work.
2. Provide information and coordination necessary to obtain permits to accomplish the work in accordance with the rules established by the Lane Regional Air Pollution Authority and the Eugene Fire Marshal.
3. Identify and clearly mark the boundaries of the site to be burned; coordinate and implement site preparation work in accordance with the results of cooperative burn planning efforts.
4. Provide pre- and post-burn labor and equipment support as requested by the Fire Management Official designated by the BLM.

**The Bureau of Land Management, Eugene District will:**

1. Develop and coordinate with Willamette Valley Project staff a burn plan specific to the areas to be burned.
2. Provide consultations, pre-burn and post-burn notifications as required by local burn permit authorities.
3. Provide trained personnel, supervision, equipment, and supplies necessary to safely and efficiently implement the burn plan.

Reimbursement for services:

Reimbursement of the Bureau of Land Management for services provided under this Order will be made only for those services rendered prior to November 1, 2009. Funding in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 is set aside by the Corps of Engineers in PR&C %81129520 for reimbursement of the Bureau of Land Management's labor, supplies, and equipment costs incurred during performance of all or portions of the work.

Payment Procedure:

Upon completion of all or a portion of the agreed tasks in this Order, the Bureau of Land Management shall furnish an invoice evidencing the work, and as a basis upon which payment will be made to BLM. Payments will be authorized for that work which has been completed at the time of invoice submittal. Payments shall be made electronically via the Military Interdepartmental Procurement Request (MIPR) process. Invoices shall be submitted in triplicate as follows
