During a storm on March 27, 2010, on Lake Stockton, Mo, they drowned when their 14 ft fishing boat capsized in 39 degree water. Life Jackets were on board which is the legal requirement in Missouri. Possibly they could have been saved if mandatory jacket use had been a law in Missouri. Join in our mission to prevent future drowning.
