

**After Action Report**  
**Corps Foundation/USACE Partnership Free Tailgate Wrap/Banner Distribution Plan**

**I. What was Expected to Happen?** The Corps Foundation received a 2016 grant from the U.S. Coast Guard that included a proposal to purchase 125 vinyl truck tailgate wraps for U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) projects nationwide for a total of \$25,000. The cost estimate per wrap was \$150 each. The proposal also included \$22,894.09 to purchase an estimated 1,260 (3' X 8') vinyl banners and ship them to one location for distribution. The original cost estimate per banners was \$15 each, plus packaging and shipping.

**II. What Actually Occurred?**

**A. Partnership:** Distribution of tailgate wraps was coordinated through a partnership between The Corps Foundation and USACE National Water Safety Program (NWSP). The process started when the U.S. Coast Guard grant was awarded in July 2016. The first step was to develop criteria and an order form to offer free tailgate wraps and banners throughout USACE.

**B. Ordering Process:**

1. The NWSP Manager sent the order form out via email on October 17, 2016. The email was sent to the CDL-Operations Project Managers, CDL-NRM-Districts, NRM Division representatives, and National Water Safety (NWS) Committee Division Representatives. Each NWS Committee Representative then sent the email order form to all of their water safety contacts in their email group. Those email groups include Operations, Public Affairs, and Safety personnel that work to promote public water safety.
2. The orders forms (Appendix A) included proposed vehicle information (make/model year), estimates for tailgate wrap costs from a local vendor with their contact information, the assignment of two USACE local points of contact (POCs) with their contact information, 3-year fatalities, and 2-year interpretive contact information. Applicants were given until November 16 (1 month) to submit their order forms to the Corps Foundation and NWSP Manager.
3. Halfway through the ordering month on November 2, the NWSP Manager sent a reminder email, which included the USACE/GSA vehicle marking policy and tailgate wrap installation and removal instructions. There were those who questioned the authority to wrap vehicles and some that had concerns about possible damage from removing wraps prior to returning vehicles to GSA so this information was developed to resolve those concerns.

**C. Location Selection Process:**

In order to select locations to receive products, the Corps Foundation developed a spreadsheet of order form information combined with a score for each project that ranked them in priority based on need. The selection criterion score for locations to be given tailgate wraps was primarily based on visitation and whether USACE managed recreation areas at that location. USACE OMBIL FY2012 visitation and the 2012 USACE Recreation Brochure were used to score projects. Projects were given a score of 0-3 and categorized based on visitation and if they had campgrounds that were managed by USACE. For example, the highest score of 3 was given to USACE projects that ranked within the top third (959,000-13 million visits) that had USACE managed camping areas. The score of 2 was for the middle third (346,000-958,000) in visitation that had USACE managed camping areas. Those that scored 1 had the lowest third (16,000-345,000) visits, but still had USACE camping areas. The lowest score 0 was for those who didn't have any USACE managed campgrounds, but some of those without USACE camping that still had a high number of visits were offered wraps. The order form also included the number of public recreation fatalities in previous 3 fiscal years and number of direct interpretive contacts in previous 2 years to assist in selection locations so that information was also used in the distribution selection process.

## **D. Results:**

**1. Tailgate Wraps.** Seventy-seven order forms were received, but only 58 of them requested vinyl tailgate wraps. Most of the tailgate wrap requests were approved. Eight of the tailgate wrap requests were not approved because cost estimates were more than double our initial \$150 per wrap estimate. The USACE POCs at those eight locations were contacted to see if they could locate a less costly vendor. They were rural USACE projects that had to travel too far to locate a vendor. Another project, withdrew their request because their new Operations Manager didn't approve of them. Two projects that anticipated getting new trucks were offered wraps, but the new trucks did not come so they were not approved. In the end, 125 tailgate wraps were purchased for a total of 7 divisions, 21 districts, and 47 projects nationwide. Exactly \$25,165.67 was spent on wraps. Most of these wraps were installed by early April in plenty of time for visitors to be seeing them throughout USACE during the 2017 recreation season and beyond. It is estimated that well-cared-for wraps can last 5-7 years. See Appendix B for distribution.

**2. Banners.** Exactly \$23,000 was spent on manufacturing 1,447 banners (cost \$20,836.80), packaging 280 boxes (\$507.15), and shipping (\$1,656.05) to the USACE Publications Depot and eventually to 246 locations. The individual cost of each banner was \$14.40. See Appendix C for distribution.

## **III. What Went Well and Why?**

**A.** Even though projects were given a month to submit order forms there was not much of a response until the reminder email was sent. That email included the tailgate wrap policy and information about removal of wraps which answered the questions we were getting.

**B.** Some USACE personnel were not aware of the Corps Foundation when order forms were initially distributed in October. Our attendance at the Natural Resource Management Workshop in April 2017 helped make more of them aware. Some USACE projects that had declined our original offers of free tailgate wraps changed their minds once the process was explained in person.

**C.** The most exciting thing is that through this process of providing free tailgate wraps more USACE personnel became aware that they were allowed to do this and several managers wrapped more of their trucks with government funds after they received a few free ones.

## **IV. What Would You Do Differently?**

**A.** The tailgate wrap and banner fillable PDF order form and instructions were too complicated for some to understand so simplifying that would be a good idea. Sending the tailgate wrap policy and removal information at the same time as the original order form may have helped too.


**B.** Several USACE projects with high visitation and fatalities did not order tailgate wraps or banners. Perhaps they already had their own wraps and banners. Some may have been hesitant to not be without their truck so it would have been best to explain to them in the beginning that they only needed to take the tailgates to their vendor.

**C.** Numerous orders for banners came through the USACE annual water safety products catalog and not through the emailed ordering form process. Using only the well-established system of ordering free products that everyone throughout USACE is familiar with would have sufficed for banners.

**D.** It would be best to have the USACE POC send us a W-9 from their vendor as part of the initial order form. That would allow us to have it in advance from vendors that cost us over the \$600 limit.

**E.** The time involved and challenges in coordinating the purchase of tailgate wraps was underestimated. It took time to coordinate with changing USACE POCs throughout the year. Plus, vendors were sometimes slow to respond to paid invoice and W-9 requests. It would have been better to shorten the time between order form submittal with vendor estimates and actual tailgate wrap purchase.

### Tailgate Wrap and Banner Request Form Instructions

The Corps of Engineers Natural Resources Education Foundation, doing business as The Corps Foundation, received grant funds from the Sport Fish Restoration and Boating Trust Fund, managed by the U.S. Coast Guard. Through this grant The Corps Foundation is able to partner with USACE National Water Safety Program to provide pickup truck tailgate wraps and banners to promote our “Life Jackets Worn...Nobody Mourns” campaign. These instructions explain the process for obtaining these free products. A request form must be completed and returned to both Rachel Garren at [Jara15@charter.net](mailto:Jara15@charter.net) and Pam Doty at [Pamela.J.Doty@usace.army.mil](mailto:Pamela.J.Doty@usace.army.mil) by November 18, 2016 to qualify. The maximum number of products you receive is dependent on the total number of requests.

1. Provide your official project name, complete office symbol (e.g. CEMVS-OD-XX), primary and secondary point of contact (POC) names, email addresses, phone numbers, and shipping address (do not use P.O. Box addresses). The secondary POC will be responsible in case the primary POC is not able to fulfill their responsibilities. POC responsibilities include locating a vendor in your area capable of downloading the approved wrap graphic, producing, and installing tailgate wraps on one to five of your GSA pickup truck tailgates. Graphics for tailgate wraps are posted online at [www.PleaseWearIt.com](http://www.PleaseWearIt.com) for your vendor to download. If artwork needs to be revised to fit your vehicle needs, contact Pam Doty via email. Only one request form may be submitted per USACE project. Your request will be reviewed and selections made between December 2016 and January 2017. Local POCs will be notified in February how many tailgate wraps are approved to purchase. The POC must then provide an invoice or itemized bill from your local vendor to The Corps Foundation for approval in March 2017. Once your invoice is approved, tailgate wraps can be installed. Purchases will be made directly to your vendor by The Corps Foundation Special Programs Director, Rachel Garren between March-June 2017, using a Visa Debit Card over the phone. The local POC will be responsible for ensuring that wraps are installed and that The Corps Foundation receives a paid receipt from your local vendor. Also, photos of installed wraps should be emailed to Pam Doty.
2. Provide the number of your employees who directly receive The Corps Foundation newsletter emails (approximately one each quarter). In your emailed submission of this form, include email addresses for all employees who would like to receive our newsletter directly (not forwarded). Membership is not required.
3. Please list the number of public water-related recreation fatalities at your location in fiscal years (FYs) 2014, 2015, and 2016.
4. List the average number of Direct Interpretive Contacts (according to OMBIL definition) your project has had for fiscal years 2015 and 2016.
5. Provide information on the local tailgate wrap vendor (company name, POC name, phone, email, and regular mailing addresses) who can provide and install tailgate wraps on your GSA pickup trucks. It is recommended that POCs locate more than one vendor and then provide information from the one that costs the least.
  - a. Confirm that the vendor you have selected will take a Visa Debit Card from the Corps Foundation’s Grant Manager, Rachel Garren over the phone. If you check “unknown” it will decrease your chances of being selected for tailgate wraps so it is best to know this in advance.
  - b. List the make, model, and number of years you estimate you will be using this pickup, as well as the cost estimate for each tailgate wrap as the number of wraps increase. Identify by letter code the primary use of each truck (**R** for Ranger, **M** for Maintenance and **B** for both). We strongly suggest you select GSA trucks most visible to your recreational customers, such as ranger patrol vehicles.
6. Describe the type of locations you would like to place 3-foot by 8-foot vinyl banners at your project. For example, names of beach, boat ramp, campground, or lock wall, etc. After vinyl banners are purchased in February 2017, USACE will be shipping them in the March-April 2017 timeframe, for you to install.
