- ➤ Be aware of partnership paperwork that will be required to execute (Challenge Partnership Agreement)
- >Funds managed by COE
 - >provides more control reg compliance, reporting
 - >may be more restrictive contracting
- > Funds managed by partner
 - >not currently permitted
 - >less control, but less restrictive






Handshake application will entertain SCA interns as a handshake project

Downside to using SCA interns:



- Challenging to get paperwork through the U. S. Army Medical Research Acquisition Activity (FT. Deitrich).

- ➤ Oversight once onboard.
