PAC Meeting Minutes 25 July 2019 1200 CT

Corps Foundation update: Greg Miller

- Fall Retreat (SEP 17-18). Scheduled and ready to go in Portland, OR. Meeting room at Corps district office. CF is now working on travel arrangements
- Board Nomination Committee Update. New board member has been voted on and approved a former district commander! Name will be announced shortly (week or so). Maybe some other members coming on board soon. Ongoing recruitment.
- NRM Stories Update. Official name still in the works, but a story book from (mostly) retired rangers to give a historical perspective of the Corps NRM/Ranger program. Editing and cover art are being worked, and publication date anticipated this fall
- Coast Guard Grants. Grant was accepted as a 3-year proposal. Funding only received one year at a time, but were able to submit once, and then budget proposals for the following two years. Grant was increased from \$175k to \$195k.
- The main products to be produced with this grant will be a competition with high schools to create public safety announcements, and prize money will be associated with it.
- Mobile game will be updated and improved.
- CF is also sponsoring advertising in state fishing guides. Two in FL, one in GA, one in OK, one in NC, one in SC.
- o Promotional items shirts, beach towels, patches
- Enduring Service Award –awardees selected from Canyon Lake and Lake Texoma. Trying to track down the nominating ranger. Greg Miller will send names to Tennille to work with her to try to track down a Texoma POC.
- o Consolidating nomination request for Enduring Service and VoY.

 - o FY21 may need a tighter execution window (1 year vs. 2?)

 - o Internet Explorer doesn't work with this system but firefox or chrome do
 - o Login info didn't work initially because it had to be used within 24 hours
- Testing team Heather, Taylor, Bobby Jackson, Pamela Backus, Taylor Saia, Hillary Coleman, Francis & volunteer Amy Schultz
- o Volunteer Clearinghouse contract ends at the end of this year. Park service is paying for the first year of Volunteer.gov, so we're going full speed. Once pricing is issued after the first year, the Corps may be priced out.
- We need to have the PII in place to be able to collect applications, so it is economically not feasible for us to have our own system. So if we get priced out, we may not have a system for the Corps.
- o It is not set in stone yet about who would have the licenses. Probably district office level, but maybe at the field or the MSC level too. It's just not feasible to issue 300 licenses for every single lake that participates
