  - Legislative Advocacy- WRDA 2020 and Appropriations 2021. Working with Congressmen Huffman's office and ORR. Suggested that we needed assessment of deferred maintenance. Language added into WRDA that has passed House. Calls for inventory of rec infrastructure facilities, O&M maintenance and deferred O&M maintenance needs, and assessment of economic benefits. Approps bill- included task force for assessment of deferred maintenance, requested \$40 million additional for O&M account and funding for studies.
- **COVID-19** – All update on operations in their MSCs, issues, lessons learned, etc. – MVK can have ADA hunts if approved by AR dept of health. Playgrounds not open but campgrounds open. NAP- everything but playgrounds open, high influx of people using trails and boat launches. Travel: MVD can travel as long as not in hotspots. NAD- not hearing about travel except survey crews, NAP 99% teleworking at district office. SAW- allowed to travel depending on where and what for, may have to quarantine when return. SPK- allowing travel but nobody is going. SWD- various approval levels, some movement for contracts, consider where traveling and meeting space, quarantine rules
