- o Changes for FY 21: Please provide heather with comments for the following:
 - Add a signoff/approve for the District POC in the Partnership Module. Include on the summary page, where all of the partnerships are listed in table format.
 - o Is there any way in this system to set up the data fields where you can't submit/sign off on the data unless you fill in certain required fields? Kinda like when you check out at Amazon or other online vendors and it won't let you proceed until you've filled in required fields such as name, email address, etc... If there's a way to add that function, we'd like to make it mandatory that you have something filled in for Total Partner Value, Corps Labor Hours, and Total Corps Value before you can click on the submit button and sign your name.
 - Add a column in the partnership report for Corps Labor Value that auto calculates by multiplying the Corps labor hours by \$60/hr. I know that is happening in the background and is already added up in the Total Corps cost and Total overall, but I think it would be nice for people to see the calculated value much like we have for the column that shows the value of volunteer services, which also auto calculates.
 - Add a new Partner Organization type to the dropdown pick list for "Native American Tribe". I noticed that we
 have reports of partnerships with a few tribal entities and the only choice that currently works is "Other",
 which can be easily remedied by adding a new category.
 - o Partner information- number of co-partners has to be manually entered. Is there a way to pull that in the forefront?
- MOUs- need to revisit and start working on these again-Any Progress?
 - o YMCA- Francis has not heard back from YMCA, just need signatures to complete.
