## PAC Meeting Minutes July 27, 2021 1330 ET

## • Corps Foundation update: Greg Miller

- **NEEF Grant Berlin Lake Grant**. Corps Foundation was selected for the Restoration and Resilience Recovery Fund grant. The grant is a partnership with Berlin Lake, to improve safety and accessibility of the Tailwater Angler Access Trail at the Mill Creek Recreation Dam. The role of the Corps Foundation in to function as a fiscal agent to administer and oversee management of the grant funds. The primary role of Berlin Lake is to oversee and manage the work plan, to improve the Tailwater Access by installing new steps, solar lighting and interpretive signing.
- **INVEST Act Advocacy**. Background: In March 2020, the advocacy team visited Congressional members during a "Day on the Hill". During the visits, met with Callie Hoyt, Director, Federal Government Relations, National Marine Manufacturers Association (NMMA) and began a series of conference calls to pursue joint advocacy efforts. As a result, Congress directed USACE to establish a Recreation Task to assess the overall condition of recreation facilities and quantify deferred maintenance and repair backlogs.
- Legislative Initiatives: Check out recent Facebook post on advocacy for the INVEST Act. It contains information on how to contact appropriate committee members with sample letters. We also are in the process of asking over 150 stakeholders to voice support to pass Federal Lands Transportation Program (FLTP) funding distribution to USACE (set FLTP funding at \$555 million with a set aside for USACE at \$16 million representing 2.8 percent of total proposed funding).
- New Reference Advocacy guide. For partners and stakeholders with search links, source information about the NRM program including list of all lakes and waterways with visitation data . It contains 117th US Congress House and Senate members, including committee and subcommittee assignments; 2022 USACE NRM program advocacy issues/initiatives; Suggested appeal letters.
- **Stakeholder Sign On Opportunity**. In July 2021, Ms. Hoyt and the Corps Foundation hosted a virtual meeting of potential partners to amplify the support for the USACE NRM Program. It resulted sign on letter to amplify interest in support of the NRM program and add voices to our Congressional outreach.
- Website Update. Our website is undergoing a complete redo. Because the website was hacked last winter our webmaster had to completely eliminate the old formatting and editing system and start over. He was able to save the content, but lost editing capability, structure and format. It has a completely new look and as soon as the editing tools are fixed we will be further updating the content. We hope to have some more creative options to make changes such as a plug in for an automatic Facebook feed. We also have an updated Innovation Team STORE.

- **CG Campaign**. This summer, the "Swimming Challenge" video PSA is being shown in movie theaters near fourteen U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) lakes. That video shows one of the most common ways that people drown. The 14 lakes selected for movie ads were those with the most water-related fatalities in the past five years. "I Got Caught" campaigns are being promoted across the nation at U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) lakes where a park ranger notices you wearing your life jacket you could get a Campaign beach towel!
