- The focus of the meetings was three-fold: WRDA 22 legislation for fee retention, fixing the Cooperative Joint Management language to include non-profits, reversing the proposed FY23 budget reduction for recreation.
- Senate has marked up their version of WRDA 22 includes language to authorize amending LWCA to include the Corps in fee retention, without an offset!
- The House version of WRDA 22 does not contain the fee retention legislation, or the technical corrections for Cooperative Joint Management Authority. Follow up- Sent letters to House committee members and Nancy has been busy making personal contacts with staffers.
