



If You Love Me ..

Teach me to swim well. Children who know how to swim well are less likely to drown than non-swimmers.

Don't let me swim alone.

One of the leading causes of accidental death for children is drowning. Make sure I swim with an adult.

Watch me closely at all times when I'm near water.

It only takes 20 seconds for a child to drown.

Don't let me use inflatable toys.

Poor swimmers often drown when inflatable toys collapse or float away.

Make sure you put a life jacket on me before] get near water.

96% of drowning victims would be alive today if they had worn a life jacket.






