Martin Luther King (MLK) Day of Service



MLK Day is the only Federal holiday designated as a Day of Service to encourage all Americans

to volunteer to improve their communities

Individuals plus volunteers from Adventist Health and the California Conservation Corps collected approximately 200 lbs. of garbage in and around Coyote Valley Dam and the South Boat Ramp.


