2020-2021 Cost Estimates for USACE

12 weeks (3 months)	\$4,970 - \$5,590	\$7,040 - \$7,660	\$8,075 - \$8,695

Assumptions:

• Weekly Living Allowance (standard): \$85/week for 12-16 week positions, \$225/week for 17-52 week positions. If desired, partners have the option of increasing the weekly rate (will also increase cost).

- Interns receive a standard Travel Grant of \$650 \$1,100 if a personal vehicle is required/mandatory. The estimated cost 'ranges' above reflect this variable.
- Interns may apply for an AmeriCorps Education Award (if eligible and as available) valued between \$1,612 and \$6,095. The actual award amount is determined by the internship length/total service hours.
- Interns serving 42 weeks or more are eligible for Health Insurance (monthly cost included in 52 week cost estimates above). If intern declines Health Insurance, costs are not billed.
- Intern housing is the responsibility of the host site. If housing is not available, a monthly "housing allowance" (rate determined by partner) will be budgeted. SCA can also hold a rental lease and pay a landlord directly. Estimated costs with \$500 and \$750/month housing allowances presented above.
- All intern allowances are subject to FICA, Medicare and SUI withholding taxes. Consequently, interns receive net amounts less than the gross weekly, monthly and/or one-time amounts stated above.
- Additional expense lines included in costs above include: SCA worker's compensation, recruitment, onboarding and enrollment, clothing/gear, SCA background check, risk management, program support, administration and FICA taxes.
- Internship lengths can be any number of weeks between 12 and 52, start at any time of year and are ultimately determined by the partner to meet site-specific project needs and/or budgetary considerations.
- All costs above are estimated; SCA will submit invoices based upon actual costs once known.
